# Sea Otters

## **Learning outcomes**

- » Students know different animals inhabit different kinds of environments and have external features that help them thrive in different kinds of places. (Grade 1 Life sciences)
- » Students know animals eat plants or other animals for food and may also use plants or even other animals for shelter and nesting. (Grade 1 Life sciences)
- » Plants and animals have predictable life cycles. (Grade2 Life sciences)
- » Students know examples of diverse life forms in different environments, such as oceans. (Grade 3 Life sciences)

- » We looked at clams and other shellfish and talked about how sea otters are able to eat them.

## **Today's craft: Sea Otter Paper Bag Puppet**



## You will need:

- » Sea otter template (included)
- » Crayons» Glue
- » Paper lunch bag
- » Scissors

## Directions:

- 1. Color the sea otter, rock and clam.
- 2. Cut out all the pieces.
- 3. Glue the otter's face on the flap at the bottom of the bag. Then, glue on the clam, rock, front and back paws and tail.
- 5. Your puppet is ready to play with.


