



Envelope Shark

Materials

1 envelope (standard letter size)
Scissors
Glue or tape
Black marker, crayon, or pencil

Directions

1. **Seal** the envelope closed and **flip it over** so the blank side faces up.
2. **Cut off** the left side of the envelope so that you can stick your hand inside.
3. **Cut** a V-shape at the bottom of the envelope and fold the "V" up on each side to make fins.
4. **Cut** a triangle out of the right side of the envelope to make the mouth.
5. **Glue** or tape the triangle you just cut out onto the top of the envelope to make the dorsal fin.
6. **Draw** an eye above the mouth and **draw** lines behind the mouth for gill slits.
7. *Optional:* **Color** your shark. Is your shark brown and striped to blend in with the sand, or dark on top and white underneath to countershade in the open ocean?
